(2)	Best view of Alnwick Castle. First parts erected in 1096, as
	protection against Scottish invasion. Owned by the Percy
	family since 1309, and home of the Duke of
	Northumberland. Second largest inhabited castle in England
(3)	Pass over the Lion bridge, built in 1770, with the Percy
	family's famous Lion, people thinks it looks like someone
	has stuffed an umbrella into it!!
(4)	Pass over the weir bridge.
(5)	Alnwick's Abbey Tower on LHS, in the Duke's Hulme Park
	estate, the wall of which you will drive along for several
	miles.
(6)	Pass over river Breamish's Bewick weak bridge.
(7)	Bridge??
(8)	Pass the entrance to Lilburn Towers built circa 1200, named
	after the stream/river Lil. Privately owned by the founder of
	Persimmon Homes and not open to the public.
(9)	Hurlestone Tower at Lilburn might be seen through the trees
	on the right, this was built in 2000 and furnished for
	conferences and meetings.
(10)	The 12 th century Chillingham Castle which was originally a
	monastery, was fortified in medieval times and was
	repeatedly attacked by the Scots. Sir Humphry Wakefield
	purchased the derelict castle in 1980, and is still in the
	process of renovating.
(11)	Pass over a bridge over river Till, just before Chatton.
(12)	Pass over the beautiful Grade listed II, Fowberry double
	arched bridge, built in 1825.
(13)	Fowberry Tower, is a Grade II listed mansion house, and has
	been owned by the Fowberry family for over 400 years and
	the 16 th century tower house incorporated the remains of an
	original Pele tower.
(14)	Carefully cross the unique Grade I listed Weetwood bridge,
	believed to have been originally built in 16 th century and in
	place for the battle of Flodden.
(15)	Doddington's ice creams are know to be exceptional, and
	should be available today, by the cow. They are $\pounds 1.25$ and
	there is an honest box.
